

Special Ed Services Notice

Parents who live in the Hallsburg ISD and think their child may need special education services may be able to get help through the Rio Brazos Education Cooperative.

The cooperative provides educational services to about 1,600 students in McLennan County who have disabilities and are between the ages of 3 and 21. Students must meet certain criteria to qualify. Children who are hearing impaired or visually impaired can be served before they are 3 years old.

Parents who believe their child may be eligible should contact a school campus, the administration or the director of special education for the cooperative.

Testing to determine if a student qualifies is free. Any educational services provided are free. All children are taught with other students as much as possible.
